Variety: Grüner Veltliner

Origin: Traisental, Austria

Analysis: dry
Alcohol: 13.5 % vol

Quality: Traisental DAC

Potential: 2018 - 2026

Site: The grapes for this wine originate from the Sonnleithen site, with old vines ("Alte Reben") partially exceeding 30 years. Southeasterly inclined slopes with deep lice soil ensure best physiological ripe grapes.

Winemaking: Grape selection, de-stemmed, crushed and after short fermentation with skin contact gently pressed in pneumatic press. Temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks, "batonnage", then aging in stainless steel tanks.

Serving: Serve chilled (10-12° C.), fits well with wide variety of dishes, including cold starters, veal and poultry as well as all fried food.
