Grüner Veltliner BERGEN „BRIGOS“

Traisental DAC Reserve 2015



History: BRIGOS is the ancient Celtic word for powerful and mighty. This wine looks into a mighty future and recognizes the foundation of wine culture in the Traisen valley by the Celtic people more than 2000 years ago.

Variety: Grüner Veltliner

Origin: Traisental, Austria

Analysis: dry
Alcohol: 14 % (vol)

Quality: Traisental DAC Reserve

Potential: 2016 - 2031

Site: The grapes for this wine originate from one of the very best sites around Wagram: Bergen, produced annually at consistently high quality standards by vines, partially 30 years or older, where southeasterly inclined slopes with deep loess soil ensure grapes with highest rating.

Winemaking: Selection of prime grapes, de-stemmed, crushed and after short fermentation with the skins pressed gently in pneumatic press. Temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks followed after fining by aging in stainless steel tanks.

Serving: Serve chilled (11-13° C.), fits well after dinner or together with creamy cheese. A wine for meditation fits excellent for a long and relaxing evening at the fireside.
